Phi Theta Kappa Eligibility for Membership

- You must generally have a grade point average of 3.5.
- You must enjoy full rights of citizenship in your country.

The organization offers myriad opportunities for scholarships, intellectual enrichment and personal development through programs based on Phi Theta Kappa's four hallmarks: Scholarship, Leadership, Service and Fellowship.
