Option A - Only one of the following documents is required to be presented by a student who chooses this option.

*These documents give the student eligibility to apply for in-state or WUE tuition rates. The student **must** complete Reg Form 64, and provide documentation as requested, in order to meet further eligibility requirements.*

- Current valid Arizona Motor Vehicle Department driver's license/identification card issued **after** October 1, 1996.
- Driver's license or non-operating license issued by another state or outlying possession of the United States where the person has provided proof of United States citizenship. (Does not include Illinois, New Mexico, Utah and Washington)
- U.S. Passport (unexpired or expired).
- Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (Form N-560 or N-561).
- Certificate of Naturalization (Form N-550 or N-570).
- Current Permanent Resident Card with photograph or alien Registration Receipt Card with photograph (Form I-151 commonly referred to as a "Green Card" or Form I-551).
- Form I-94 verifying current status (stamp) as "Refugee," "Asylum Granted," "Parolee," or "Cuban-Haitian Entrant."

*These documents make the student eligible for out-of-state rates only. The student **should not** complete Reg Form 64.*

- Current Foreign Passport with an I-551 stamp.
- Current Foreign Passport indicating nonimmigrant visa status and such visa status either has not expired or has been extended.
- Current Temporary Resident Card (Form I-688).
- Current Employment Authorization Card (Form I-688A). The permanent domicile of this person is their home country.
- Current Employment Authorization Document issued by Department of Homeland Security that contains a photograph (Form I-688B). The permanent domicile of this person is their home country.
- Current Reentry Permit (Form I-327).
- Current Refugee Travel Document (Form I-571).

Options B and C - One document from Option B and one document from Option C are required to be presented by a student who chooses these options.

Option B

*These documents give the student eligibility to apply for in-state or WUE tuition rates. The student **must** complete Reg Form 64, and provide documentation as requested, in order to meet further eligibility requirements.*

- Arizona driver's license or Arizona non-operating identification card issued **on or before** October 1, 1996.
- Driver's license that does not indicate that the person has provided proof of United States citizenship or an identification card that does not indicate that the person has provided proof of United States citizenship issued by a state or outlying possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color and address.
- Arizona voter registration card.
- U.S. military I.D. card or draft record.
- U.S. military DD-214
- U.S. military dependent's ID card.
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card.
- Native American tribal document (indicating identity of the student).

Choose one for persons under age 18 who are unable to present any of Option B documents listed above:

- School record or report card.
- School I.D. card with photo

Option C

*These documents give the student eligibility to apply for in-state or WUE tuition rates. The student **must** complete Reg Form 64, and provide documentation as requested, in order to meet further eligibility requirements.*

- United States social security card issued by the Social Security Administration (not designated as "Valid for Work Only").
- Certification of Birth Abroad issued by the Department of State (Form FS-545 or Form DS-1350).
- Original or certified copy of a birth certificate issued by a state, county, municipal authority or outlying possession of the United States bearing an official seal.
- Native American tribal document related to the student.
- U.S. Citizen ID card (Form I-197).
- Identification Card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (Form I-179).

*These documents make the student eligible for out-of-state rates only, no matter what document they used for Option B. The student **should not** complete Reg Form 64.*

- United States social security card issued by the Social Security Administration (designated as "Valid for Work Only"). The permanent domicile of this person is their home country.
- Unexpired Employment Authorization Document issued by Department of Homeland Security (other than those listed in Option A). The permanent domicile of this person is their home country.
