

Candidates for membership on the Board must file nominating petitions pursuant to Arizona statute. Pursuant to statute, nominating petitions shall be signed by not less than one-half of one percent (0.5%) of the qualified electors of the district for which the candidate is nominated. The percentage of qualified electors necessary to sign the nominating petition shall be determined by the total vote cast for governor in the district in the last general election.
