iv. London Bridge Days Parade

Each year the Lake Havasu City community enjoys the London Bridge Days Parade that includes various schools and organizations, floats, and marching bands geared toward boosting the city's community pride. MCC staff, faculty, and students participate annually in this event to highlight the college and its many student activities. This year's parade is scheduled for Saturday, October 29, 2022.

Suggested Motion:

Motion to approve a budget of \$2,500 to purchase decorations, themed attire, and beverages for the students, staff, and faculty, who volunteer to walk in the London Bridge Days Parade on Saturday, October 29, 2022.

v. MCC Shines

MCC Shines is cohosted by the LHC SAC and the MCC LHC Campus. This is a community outreach to showcase the campus, introduce campus staff and student volunteers, establish college as a fun, welcoming environment, be a service to the community, and provide an enjoyable holiday event for the community. The event typically offers entertainment, food, a holiday tree-lighting ceremony, and a contest for the best decorated tree. This is a volunteer effort by departments and student clubs.

Suggested Motion:
