- A. MCC Shines Events Committee Proposal
 - i. The Campus Events Committee would like to request additional funds from SAC for our annual MCC Shines event. We had previously allotted a budget of \$4500; however, the new lighting tree that was purchased took over 60% of that budget. That said, the proposal asks

for compensation on the tree purchase and club funds for the top 3 decorated trees in 500 with a total budget of \$3450.
