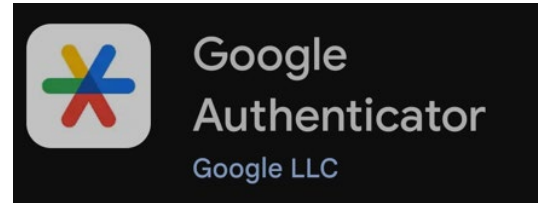
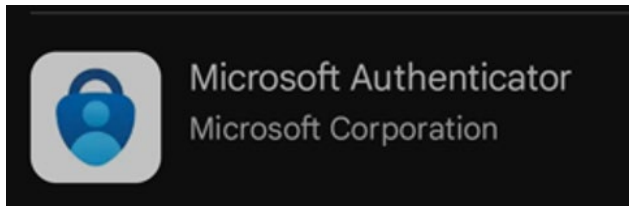


Apps that you can use: Microsoft Authenticator or Google Authenticator. **DO NOT download any apps that look similar. DO NOT enter any payment information.**



Signing into your MCC account on a computer and using Microsoft Authenticator:

Note: If the Microsoft Authenticator app asks for a “screen lock” or “app lock”, that is the method you use to unlock your phone. i.e. pin code, pattern, fingerprint, or face ID.

Note: After setting up the authentication app, **DO NOT DELETE THE APP OR YOUR ACCOUNT IN THE APP.**

1. After putting in the email and password, you will see the message below, click “Next”.

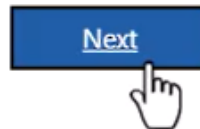

3. On the phone app, allow for notifications, then select "Add Work or School Account", then "Scan QR Code", then select "Next" on the computer. DO NOT CLOSE OUT YOUR APP AND OPEN YOUR PHONES CAMERA SEPERATELY OR TRY TO USE YOUR QR SCANNER.

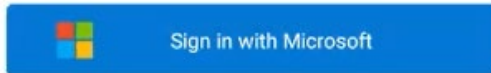

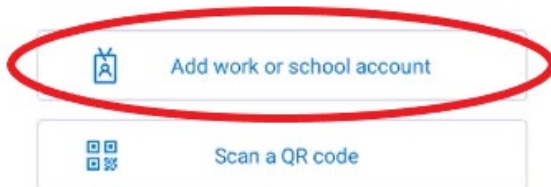

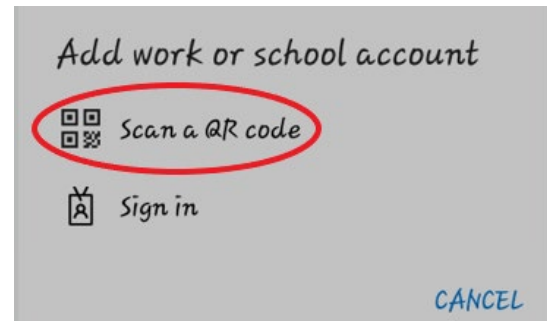

4. After selecting “Scan a QR code”, your phone’s camera will automatically open, after have selecting “Next” on the computer screen you should see the following message with a QR code. Point your camera at the QR code. The QR code will automatically sign you into your MCC account on the authentication app on your phone, then select “Next” on the computer screen.

5. You will then see a 2-digit code on your computer screen, look for a popup notification at the top of your phone that says "Are you trying to sign in?", tap on the notification and enter the 2-digit code shown on your computer screen, then select "Yes".
