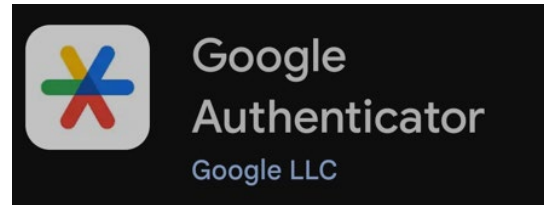
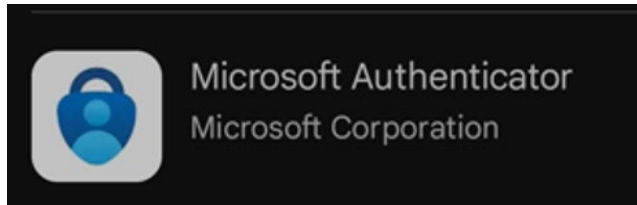


Apps that you can use: Microsoft Authenticator or Google Authenticator. **DO NOT download any apps that look similar. DO NOT enter any payment information.**

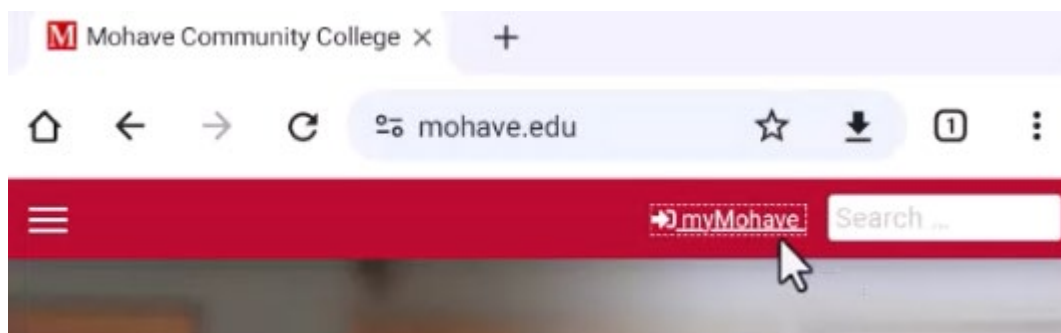
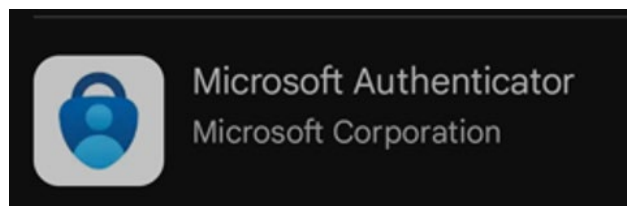


Signing into your MCC account on a mobile device and using Microsoft Authenticator:

Note: If the Microsoft Authenticator app asks for a “screen lock” or “app lock”, that is the method you use to unlock your phone. i.e. pin code, pattern, fingerprint, or face ID.

Note: After setting up the authentication app, DO NOT DELETE THE APP OR YOUR ACCOUNT IN THE APP.

1. On your phone, download the Microsoft Authenticator app from the app store, then open your browser and go to Mohave.edu and select “MyMohave”.



2. After putting in the email and password, you will see the message below, click “Next”.

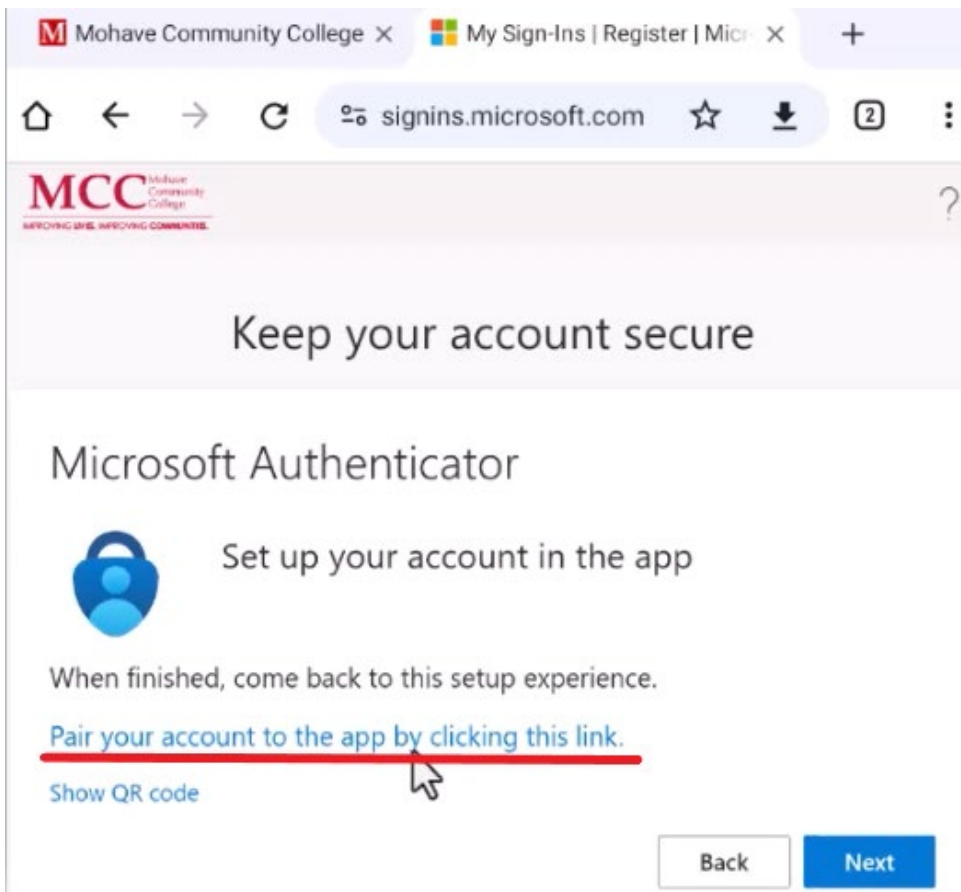

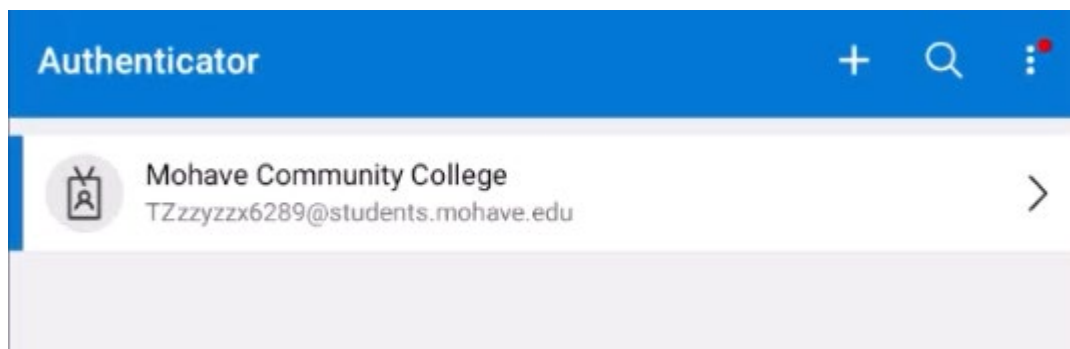

4. Select "Pair your account to the app by clicking this link."

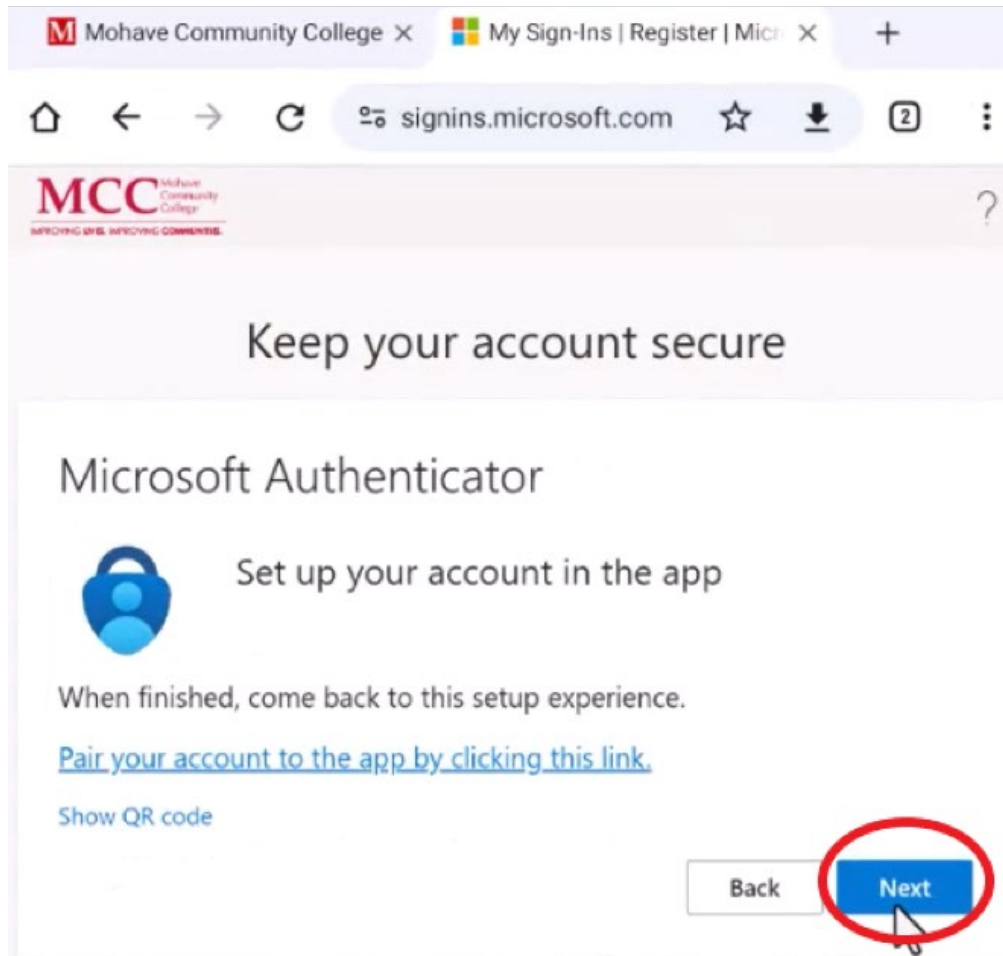


5. The Microsoft Authenticator app will automatically open and sign you in, you will see this page: you do not need to click on it.

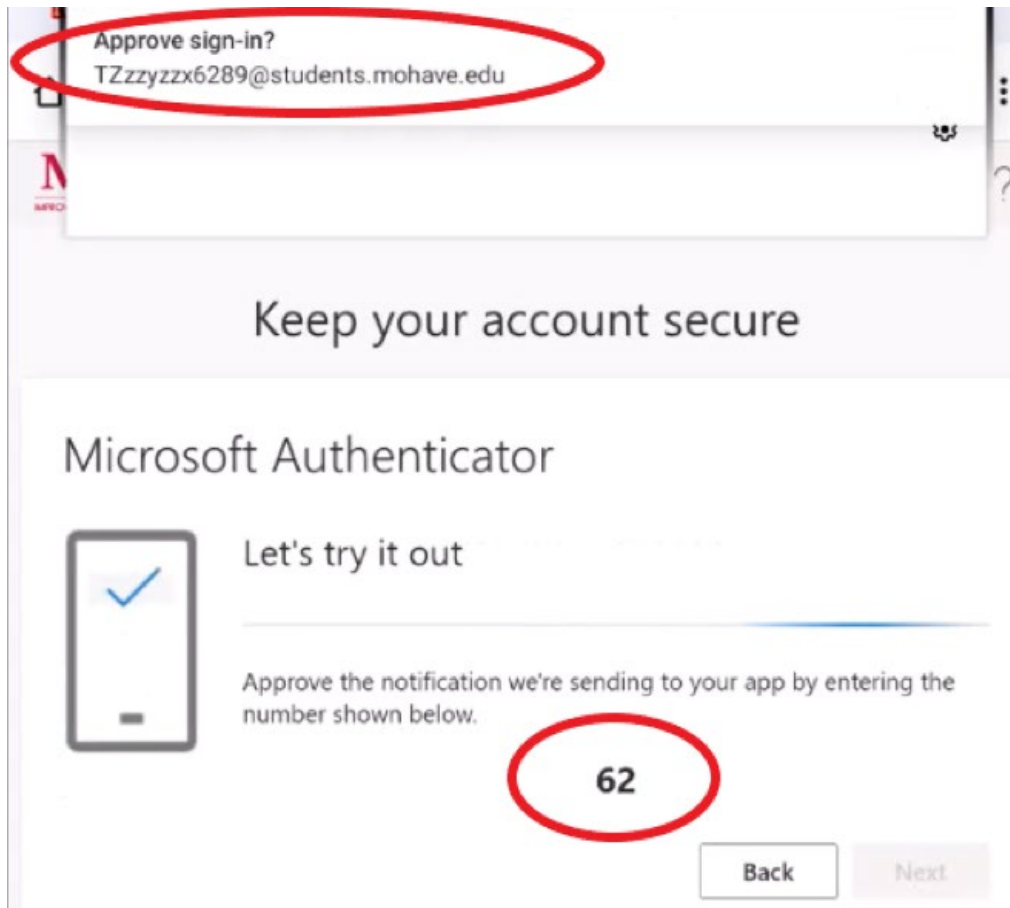
Note: if you are asked if you would like to allow permissions for notifications, you need to select Allow.



6. Do not select the back button, toggle to your open pages and open the MCC login page on your browser and select “Next”.

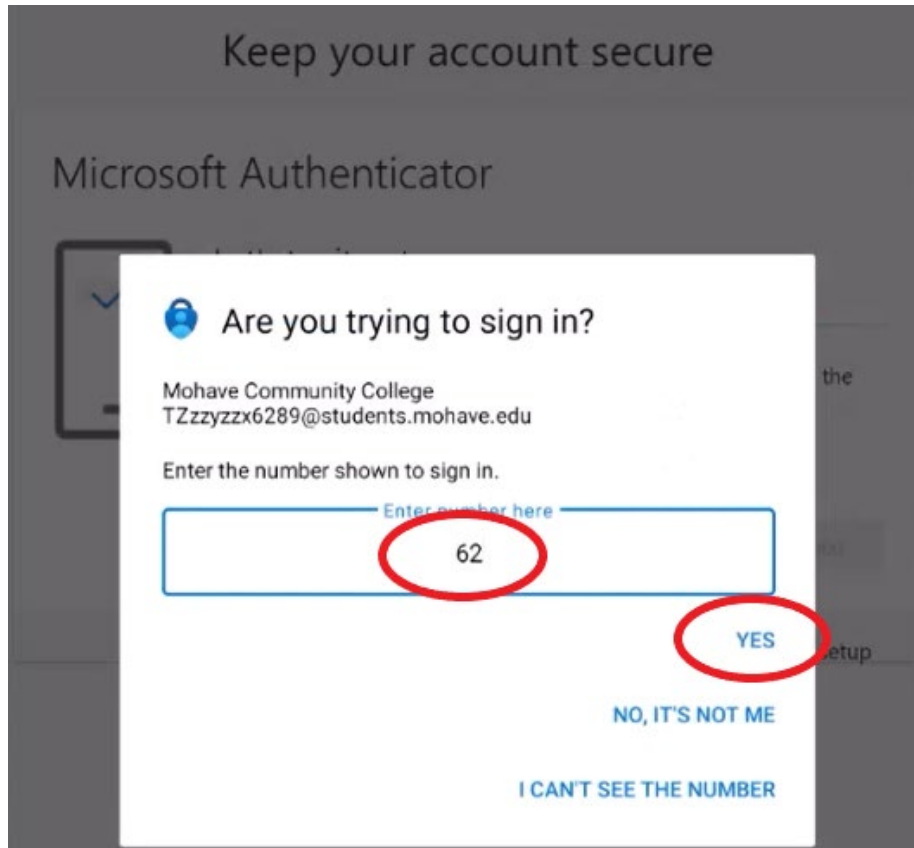


7. You will see a 2-digit code populate on the screen, remember that number, and look for the popup notification at the top of your phone that says “Approve sign-in?”



8. Once you have the 2-digit code, tap on the “Approve sign-in” notification and insert the code on the popup window that appears, then select “Yes”

Note, you may need to pull your notification bar down to open the popup window. To do this, hold your finger at the very top of your screen and swipe down.



9. After selecting “Yes” on the popup, the window will close and your sign in page will update, select “Next” and then “Done”.
