

## Applying to the Mohave Community College Dental Hygiene Program

Locate the application online, <https://www.mohave.edu/academics/certificates/dentalhygiene/>. Attach the following documents when applying: ATI TEAS 7 Score (required), Registered Dental Hygienist Observation Verification (required), Employee Dental Work Verification (optional), Unofficial Transcripts (required) and Dental Assisting Certification(s) (optional). Be sure to read the *Frequently Asked Questions* before starting your application.

### POINT SYSTEM (217 possible pts)

- ATI TEAS 7 Score – Max 115 pts
  - Bonus Points
    - 70 – 77% = 5 pts
    - 78 – 90% = 10 pts
    - >90% = 15 pts
- Prerequisite Courses – Max 84 pts
- Work Experience – Max 5 pts
- MCC Dental Assisting Graduate or a CODA Program Graduate – Max 5 pts
- Assisting Certification – Max 5 pts
  - DANB Certified Dental Assistant or equivalent – 5pts OR
  - DANB RHS Certificate – 5 pts
- Residency – Max 3 pts
  - Arizona – 1 pt AND
  - Mohave County – 2 pts OR
  - Arizona Western College – 2 pts

The registrar must evaluate prerequisite courses completed at an institution other than MCC. Official transcripts **MUST** be sent directly to the Registrar's Office by the granting institution. Mohave Community College, Office of the Registrar, 1971 Jagerson Ave, Kingman, AZ 86409. ### Frequently Asked Questions –

Q. Am I eligible to apply for early acceptance?

A. Students who are taking prerequisite classes in the summer are not eligible for early acceptance. A minimum of 170 points at the time of application is required for early consideration.

Q. Can I observe a dentist for the Registered Dental Hygienist Observation?

A. No, you must observe a Registered Dental Hygienist.

Q. Do most accepted students have dental experience?

A. About half of the students accepted into our program have previous dental experience.

Q. Can I save the application before submitting?

A. Yes, the application can be saved.

Q. How can I prepare for the TEAS test?

A. The MCC testing center has information available - <https://www.mohave.edu/resources/testing-services/>.

Q. I am having trouble uploading documents in the application, what should I do?

A. The file to be uploaded must be a pdf or jpeg. If the correct file type is being used, try clearing your browser history and using Chrome. If you still have difficulties, contact MCC Connect at 1-866-664-2832 for assistance.

Q. What is the minimum grade point average (GPA) required for acceptance?

A. The minimum GPA is 2.8. Only prerequisite courses are included in the GPA calculation.

Q. When will I hear if my application is accepted?

A. The designation of approved, approved – prerequisites in progress, incomplete or denied is sent to your MCC student email within one week of application. This initial review is not program acceptance. Formal acceptance to the program occurs in the weeks following the due dates of April 1 and June 1 via email.

Q. How many students apply each year?

A. Applications fluctuate from year to year. The number has ranged from 18 – 75.

Q. What does the program cost?

A. Find this information on the MCC Dental Hygiene program page under Program Information.

Q. Is the Dental Hygiene program eligible for the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) tuition rate?

A. Yes.

Q. Can I use remote proctoring for the TEAS exam?

A. No, only in-person proctoring will be accepted for TEAS results.
