<p>These courses prepare students to take the AP exam and potentially earn college credit.</p> <p>Colleges award credit based solely on the student's AP exam score, and it may apply as elective or required credit depending on the student's program of study and the college or university they attend.</p>	<p>College classes that meet outside regular high school hours and typically do not take place on the high school campus.</p> <p>Students take courses online, via Zoom, or in person at Mohave College. Some high schools also offer a study hall period for participating students.</p>	<p>Earn both high school and college credit, and receive both grades, for work completed during the school year.</p> <p>Classes meet during the regular high school day in a traditional high school class, and are taught by qualified high school teachers.</p>
<p>Exam scores provided by College Board</p>	<p>Credit shows on College transcript.</p> <p>WAVE JTED reports grades to the High School for credit.</p> <p>Mohave College reports grades to High School when course counts toward HS diploma.</p>	<p>Credit shows on High School transcript and College transcript.</p>
<p>Advanced Placement (AP) exams typically incur exam costs.</p> <p>Check with your local high school about AP Exam fees.</p>	<p>Mohave College Early Start Scholarship or partnership with WAVE JTED can cover tuition and fees for courses.</p> <p>Tuition and fees may apply to student when taking concurrent college classes.</p>	<p>FREE at Mohave College</p>
