

**The college shall establish procedures regulating the appearance of political candidates or political organizations on campuses.**

Appearances by Political Organizations on Campuses

The college should be a forum for debate on almost all issues, and the appearance on campus by political candidates or organizations is encouraged.

Political candidates or organizations wishing to hold informational meetings on the campuses should apply in writing to the campus dean, who will make a recommendation to the President. The final decision will be made by the President. The application for appearance must identify in general the topics to be discussed or aired at the meeting.

The college must not endorse, or appear to endorse, any candidate or political position on any issue. Other than a press release or a marquee announcement of the meeting, no political or candidate signs are to be placed anywhere on the property of the college. Other than “get out the vote” documents or brochures, no written materials espousing political positions or candidates are to be distributed on campus.
