

Student activities councils shall be approved by the College President, and with approval, may be formed at individual campuses for the purposes of providing a channel of communication between students and the professional staff of the College and providing a learning experience through participation in student leadership including the sponsorship of student clubs, activities and events.

Student Government/Organizations

MCC has a Student Activities Council (SAC) at each campus that serves as an umbrella to all other student clubs and organizations. Campus SACs provide possible assistance in funding and additional guidance in establishing events and activities that foster leadership and growth. All registered students are members of the campus SAC and may be eligible to run and be elected to hold office, provided they meet the established requirements per the MCC Student Life Handbook which is found in the Student Handbook located at: <http://catalog.mohave.edu/>
