

Students are primarily responsible for their own academic performance and it is expected that satisfactory progress, in terms of credit granted, will be made each semester during which the student is enrolled. A review of each student's progress will be made after each period of enrollment.

Academic Amnesty

1. Past academic performance may not, for a variety of reasons, be reflective of a student's subsequent demonstrated ability.
2. The Mohave Community College academic amnesty policy permits students to have up to two consecutive semesters of coursework excluded from calculating their academic standing, cumulative grade point average and eligibility for degree or certificate completion. Academic amnesty can be granted only once and is irrevocable. Since the student's complete record remains on the transcript, other institutions may consider all classes when a student transfers.
3. Petitions can be initiated by contacting an academic advisor who will assist in submitting a Request for Academic Amnesty to the registrar's office.
4. Since academic amnesty may affect financial aid awards, students receiving financial aid should contact the financial aid office prior to applying for amnesty.

Academic Integrity

A student is responsible for the academic integrity of all work completed for a given course. All reports, papers, projects and examinations must represent the student's own work.
