

The Board is authorized to name college facilities and other real property for individuals and organizations that have made a significant contribution of monies or property to the college.

Naming of Facilities

1. The Board, President, faculty, staff, Mohave Community College Foundation or a citizen may request the President of the college or the Board of Trustees, individually or collectively for inclusion on the agenda, to name a facility or other property after an individual (living or deceased), a family, a company, or a corporate entity. The request shall be made by the completion of a standardized form which is available to all interested parties. The standardized form shall contain at a minimum:
 - a. The name of the individual, family, company or corporate entity to be so honored.
 - b. Biographical information and a detailed account of the contributions and/or personal service provided to Mohave Community College.
 - c. Printed name, address and signature of the requesting individual or entity.
2. An individual, family, company or corporate entity for whom a college facility or property is named must meet the following criteria:
 - a. A citizen, family, company or corporate entity who has contributed significant monies or property to Mohave Community College.
3. Former employees:
 - a. Employees are not eligible to have facilities or other real property named after them for their work as a college employee. Employees are eligible for such honor should a significant gift of monies or property be given in their name after leaving college employment.
4. The President or Board member shall report for 1st reading the request for nomination to a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board. The Board shall make a final decision on the naming of any facility or property belonging to the community college district, however, the Board may not act on a nomination at the meeting it is received.
