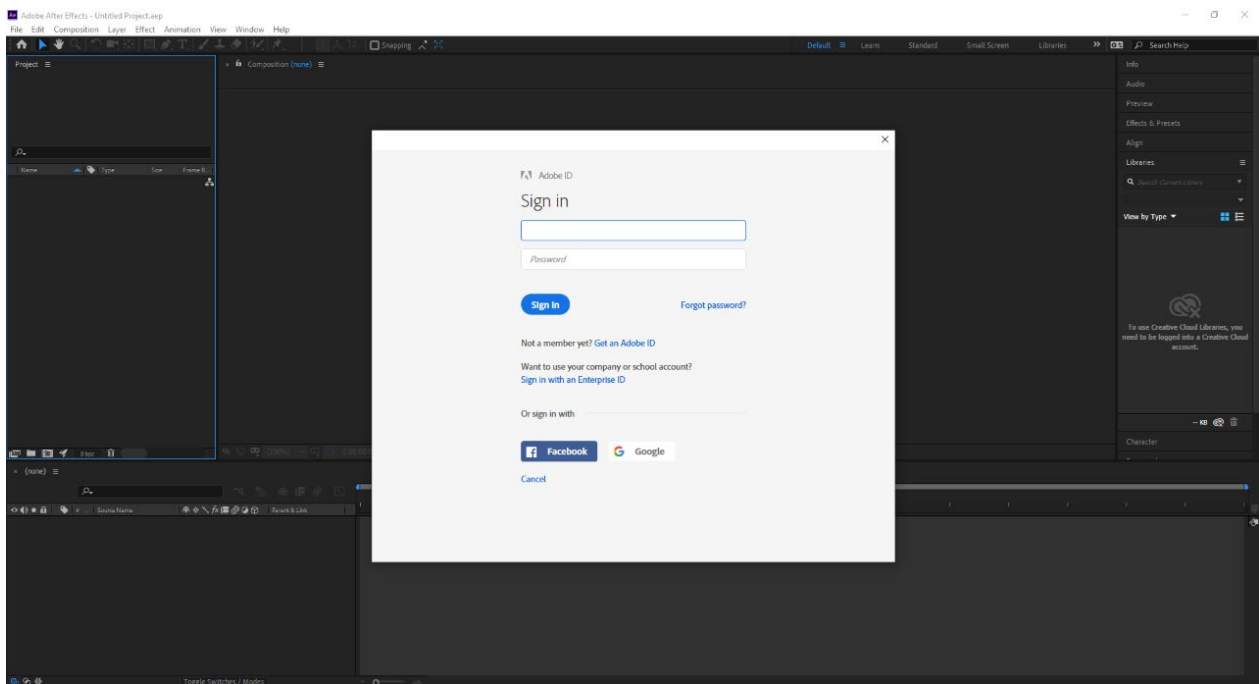



Adobe Login for Students

Students can access Adobe applications on desktops located in the campus libraries, computer labs, and MAC rooms. Students can also use view.mohave.edu at home to access Adobe applications at no cost.

To start using Adobe applications, students will need an Adobe ID login. When you click on the application, a sign in box will appear:




If you already have an Adobe ID, you can sign in to start using the application. If you do not have an Adobe ID, click on the “Get an Adobe ID” link.


