

2016-17 Scholarship Guide

Apply for scholarships by completing 3 simple steps by *April 1, 2016*:

- Be [admitted](#) to MCC
- File the [2016-17 FAFSA](#)
- Complete the 2016-17 Scholarship Application in NetPartner. Access to NetPartner is available once you have been admitted and your FAFSA is on file with MCC.

General Requirements for Scholarship Recipients

- Submit a scholarship acceptance form by the deadline stated in the offer letter
- Submit a thank you letter to MCC for the scholarship donor (if requested)
- Declare a degree program at MCC
- Enroll in a minimum of 6 credits per semester that satisfy your degree program
 - Credits must be “financial aid” eligible
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA at MCC*
- Maintain [Satisfactory Academic Progress](#) (SAP) or successfully appeal the suspension and continue meeting the terms of the appeal/academic plan at MCC

*Scholarships will be canceled at the point the student’s cumulative GPA drops below 2.5, if the student is suspended for not meeting the SAP policy, or the student fails to meet the terms of the appeal/academic plan. At the point of cancelation, scholarship funds will be awarded to an alternate recipient.

Scholarship Deferment:

Students may request to have their scholarship deferred for up to two years if serving in the United States Military, Peace Corps, as an AmeriCorps VISTA volunteer, or church service. The student must identify themselves by providing verification of this service along with a letter requesting the deferment.

Employee tuition benefits:

A tuition waiver recipient is not eligible to receive a tuition waiver benefit, college-funded scholarships, or awards for tuition concurrently in any semester (MCC PPM 4.130.03.01).

Mohave Community College Institutional Scholarships

Mohave Community College offers an array of scholarships to new and continuing students based on academic merit and / or financial need. These scholarships are generously funded by the MCC Board of Governors. Funds are limited and will be awarded until funds are exhausted.

Apply early to receive the best consideration. **Priority Deadline for all scholarships is April 1, 2016.**
