

NUR 110 - Health Concepts II

Course Description

This course introduces the student to commonly occurring acute and chronic health issues with predictable outcomes across the lifespan, including concepts of child bearing family. This course includes a skills/simulation laboratory and clinical experience.

Pre-requisites: NUR 105 - Health Concepts I

Course Student Learning Outcomes:

1. Apply the nursing process to safely provide care for patients with commonly occurring acute and chronic health problems with predictable outcomes across the lifespan. (2,3,4,5,6)
2. Apply the nursing process to care for the childbearing family, including health promotion and teaching. (2,3,4,5,6)
3. Demonstrate invasive psychomotor skills based on evidence-based standards. (3,5,6)

5. Apply informatics and technologies when providing and documenting patient care. (3,5,6)
