I want to thank you all for your continued hard work helping our students during this pandemic, and provide you with an update on the plans moving forward.

Currently the college is preparing for spring semester, and you're most likely aware that the COVID-19 cases continue to quickly surge in Mohave County. Right now, the county expects the number of cases to continue this upward trend through January, and public health professionals are asking each of us to do our part to help reduce the spread. As a result, Mohave Community College will make the following temporary adjustments:

- Student Services and all other college operations will move from on-campus to solely online and virtual services beginning on **December 14**.
- During this time only employees who have approval from their supervisors and the campus dean will be allowed on campus.
- **All spring semester courses** will be held in **remote and online formats**, with some labs held on campus. This is a continuation of the instructional procedures the college followed for fall semester.

If you need to be on campus please contact your supervisor and the campus dean. Before you come to campus, please know [VIRUS SYMPTOMS](#) and check to make sure you do not have any of them. **DO NOT** come to campus **IF YOU DO NOT FEEL WELL**.
