As we near the end of the semester, I want to encourage you to stay focused and finish strong. For those of you graduating this month, congratulations! Currently the college is preparing for spring semester, and you're most likely aware that the COVID-19 cases continue to quickly rise in Mohave County. Right now, the county expects the number of cases to continue this upward trend through January, and public health professionals are asking each of us to do our part to help reduce the spread. As a result, Mohave Community College will make the following temporary adjustments:

- Student Services and all other college operations will move from on-campus to solely online and virtual services beginning on **December 14**.
- During this time, only employees who have approval from their supervisors and the campus dean will be allowed on campus.
- **All spring semester courses** will be held in **remote and online formats**, with some labs held on campus. This is a continuation of the instructional procedures the college followed for fall semester.

Free COVID-19 testing is available through [Embry Women's Health](#) at the Bullhead City, Neal Campus-Kingman, and Lake Havasu City campus. Testing is free for everyone, regardless of insurance.
