A. Library Proposal for Funds for “Voices and Votes: Democracy in America 2020” Smithsonian Traveling Exhibit

The MCC Libraries on the Lake Havasu City, Bullhead, and Kingman campuses are asking their respective SACs for \$750 each for a total of \$2,250 to match the \$2,000 grant awarded from AZ Humanities to help fund the “Voices and Votes: Democracy in America 2020” Smithsonian Traveling Exhibit, which will be coming to the LHC Campus on August 8, 2020. The money will be used to fund speakers, supplies for a companion exhibit, a kick-off party, events, activities, and miscellaneous supplies.
