A. 80's Themed Dance Planning Committee Update

At the February 15, 2019, meeting, SAC approved hosting an 80's-themed dance on April 25, 2019, at a budget amount of up to \$5,000 for the rental of a portable dance floor, a photo booth, entertainment, food, refreshments, and incidentals. A planning committee was called at that time by Sunshine Boylan to plan the event. Before beginning to plan the dance, the members agreed at the March 1 SAC meeting to survey the student body to see what their interest is in having the dance and whether they would like the dance open to just students, students and their guest, or students and their families, including children. Each member agreed to walk around with a survey sheet and to get the surveys back to Diane Aquino in the Campus Dean's office by March 6. Those surveys now need to be evaluated.
