VI. Old Business

A. Smoke-Free Campus Committee Report

President Mahler reported that 16 students responded to the survey sent out and most of them were against a smoke-free campus. She will provide more updates at the next SAC meeting.

B. Filming Station Committee Report

President Mahler shared the project’s purpose, details, and proposed expenditures. A filming station for students who do not have access to one for their assignments would be a great opportunity to meet that need for them, as well as a great signature project for the current SAC to leave for future students. A scope of rooms in the Library were identified, and a room for the station will be verified soon. The necessary equipment and items for the project is estimated to be approximately \$3,300. Considering shipping costs and any price fluctuations at the time of purchase, the SAC is requested to approve a budget of \$4,000.

Vice President Adams motioned, and Melissa Martinez seconded that motion, to approve a budget of up to \$4,000 for equipment and items for a student filming station to be set up in a room in the Library on the LHC Campus. Without further discussion, the motion carried.

C. SAC Meeting Schedule

President Mahler reported that students and clubs were surveyed and the majority of them agreed to move the SAC meetings to biweekly on Thursdays, at 12 p.m., beginning March 11.

Melissa Martinez motioned, and Vice President Adams seconded that motion, to reschedule the SAC meetings to biweekly Thursdays at 12 p.m., beginning with the meeting on March 11. Without further discussion, the motion carried.

D. Virtual Spring Bash

President Mahler shared the details of a two-day Virtual Spring Bash that is planned for Monday, April 5, 3:00 – 4:30 p.m. and Tuesday, April 6, 10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. This event will give students the opportunity to interact with other students, campus clubs, and departments in a fun and interactive way. Each club or department will have a break-out room, where they will host fun and informative games or activities. A host in the main zoom room will greet students and send participants through the break-out rooms. Students who participate will be entered into a drawing for prizes. The club with the best activity will be awarded a monetary prize. The approximate cost for prizes for students, as well as a monetary gift for the club with the best activity, is \$1,550. SAC is asked to approve a budget of up to \$1,650 for this event.

Melissa Martinez made a motion, and Mike Adams seconded that motion, to approve a budget of up to \$1,650 for prizes for students and clubs during the Virtual Spring Bash to take place on Monday, April 5, and Tuesday, April 6.
