



GED Information

There are five timed sections in the GED exam:

- Reasoning Through Language Arts: 150 minutes
- Mathematical Reasoning: 115 minutes
- Science: 90 minutes
- Social Studies: 70 minutes
- Arizona Civics Exam: 120 minutes

The fee for the GED exam is \$35 per section, except for the Civics section which is \$9, (\$149 total) payable at the time of on-line registration at www.ged.com .

Each of the sections, except for Civics, requires a minimum test score of 145 to pass. The Civics section requires 60 out of 100 questions correct to pass.

If you must retake a section of the exam, the cost will be up to \$35 per section.

GED exam applicants' responsibilities:

1. Register for the GED at www.ged.com . When scheduling please keep in mind that you may need to schedule one subject at a time to allow the time span to fit within the Testing Centers' schedule.
2. If you are 16 or 17 years of age, before you can register for an exam at www.ged.com you must bring all of the following to a Testing Coordinator:
 - A withdrawal statement from the last school attended
 - A notarized statement (See your local Testing Coordinator for the proper document.) from your parent or legal guardian giving you permission to take the GED exam.
 - A valid Photo ID
3. At the time of your test, you are required to have a valid photo identification with you.

Acceptable forms of photo ID are: a current driver's license, state-issued ID card, valid passport, military ID, or other forms of government ID (foreign, domestic,

tribal). Questions about acceptable I.D. should be directed to the Testing Coordinator at your testing center.

GED Test Accommodations:

The GED Testing Program provides accommodations to candidates who have disabilities and is committed to compliance with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Accommodations are made for candidates who have diagnosed physical, mental, sensory or learning disabilities and can provide appropriate documentation from a qualified professional of their impairment and its effect on their ability to take the GED Tests under standard conditions. Arrangement for accommodations is made through www.ged.com during the registration process.
