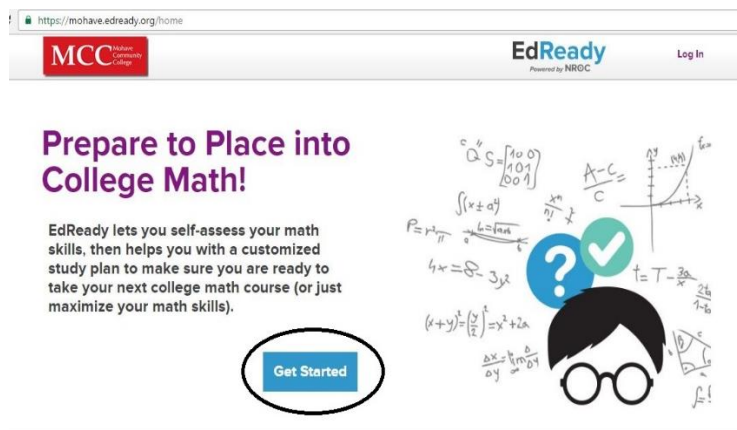


# EDREADY

- To sign up for ed-ready enter the link **mohave.edready.org**
- To create an account click the Get Started button on the homepage of ed-ready. Once you have clicked the “Get Started” button complete the following form to register and create an account.



Once you have filled out the form to create and account for EdReady, please check your email that you have used for creating and account in order to verify your account and complete the registration.

Once you have verified your account, return to the EdReady page and then click Log In in the upper right hand corner.

Once you have logged in you will enter a key to add goals” and then enter **mathskills** (lowercase) as needed for your program of study or as recommended by an advisor.

- Once you have clicked the submit button, you will see a new course in *You Goals* that says **Refresh Your Math Skills – Basic to Trigonometry** Click “Go to Goal” to begin working in EdReady.

## What do you want to be ready for?

EdReady will help you prepare for college level math courses. You can prepare to take the Accuplacer and/or review and refresh your math skills in general. You can study math to your heart's content!

Go to Goal

In this goal, you'll study as much or as little math as you want. You can study specific topics or every fun math topic we have! After you take the initial diagnostic, a study plan will be prepared for you to work through at your own pace.

Topics range from Basic Math to Trigonometry.

The Student Success Center is equipped to help you with any material you may struggle with and after you've finished this pathway you will be provided with documentation to share with your academic advisor that indicates successful completion of the math modules.

### Complete this assessment to gain an understanding of your math readiness.

Answer the questions as best you can, without study aids, in order to get the most accurate picture of your current understanding.

There is no built-in calculator for EdReady. Some exams (e.g., Accuplacer) allow the use of calculators for some problems, but not others. Use your judgment (or ask your teacher) to decide whether it is appropriate to use a calculator for some or all of this assessment.

The time of completion will vary. Expect to take about an hour.

If you need to leave before your assessment is complete, your work will automatically be saved until your next visit to EdReady.
