

Dear Parent/Guardian:

During a child's junior and senior years of high school, many parents/guardians find themselves wondering, "How am I going to afford a college education for my child?" At Mohave Community College, we can help motivate and assist high school students through a special program created by the Arizona Legislature called "dual enrollment."

### **What is dual enrollment?**

The dual enrollment Program at Mohave Community College provides eligible high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to earn both High school and college credits at the same time. Eligible students can earn college credits that count towards their [Arizona General Education Curriculum](#) (AGEC), which provides High school graduation credits and college credits. This opportunity will jump-start their future to continue after High school graduation at Mohave Community College or transfer to a University.

### **How does dual enrollment help me afford a college education for my child?**

Dual enrollment courses at Mohave Community College are FREE (tuition, fees, and textbooks included) for eligible high school students. Mohave Community College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission, **and** many of our dual enrollment courses transfer to public and private universities in Arizona, as well as out-of-state institutions.

### **Where will my child take dual enrollment Courses offered by Mohave Community College?**

Mohave Community College offers dual enrollment courses on most high school campuses in Mohave County. Many high schools offer a structured space for a variety of dual enrollment courses *online* to broaden course offerings geared towards the Arizona General Education Curriculum.

### **What are the requirements to enroll in a dual enrollment Course?**

Dual enrollment students must:

1. Be classified as a high school junior or senior.
2. Discuss course options with high school counselors.
3. Meet course placement and pre-requisites as outlined in the MCC Course Catalog.
4. Complete the admissions process at MCC.

### **How does my child enroll in dual enrollment courses?**

high school students will meet with their high school counselor to discuss course options that fit their schedule. Students will need to apply for admissions with Mohave Community College at [apply.mohave.edu](http://apply.mohave.edu). Students will work with their local MCC Recruiter to submit admissions documentation.

For more information on dual enrollment at MCC, contact the recruiter on your local campus.

*Please note that once a student is enrolled in a post-secondary institution, parents cannot have access to the student's MCC academic record without the student's written consent. The student may grant MCC permission to release authorized information to a third party (i.e., parent) by submitting a completed Family Education Rights and Privacy Act FERPA form, which is available in the students' MyMohave account at [JICS.mohave.edu](http://JICS.mohave.edu).*
